Dec. 20, Sunday

Dec. 22, Tuesday

King Herod and Jesus' Infancy

Visit Masada (Jewish Stronghold against the Romans). Drive north to Beit Shean/ Scythopolis to walk through the ruins. Then head north to Nazareth and the Church of Annunciation, discuss the archaeological remains of the city and enjoy the religious art work from different countries displayed at the church.

Stop by the Yardenit, which is the Jordan River baptismal site, with the opportunity (weather permitting) to renew your baptismal vows.

Dec. 23, Wednesday

Jesus Ministry around the Sea of Galilee

Visit Capernaum (Synagogue, and the Octagonal Church). In Tabgha, visit the Church of the Multiplication, (Loaves and Fishes) the traditional location for the feeding of the 5000.

Visit the ruins of Chorazin. You will stand on the Mt. of Beatitudes Church, where Jesus gave his sermon. We will provide a St. Peters Fish lunch then enjoy a relaxing boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.

Dinner and Overnight Ein Gev Kibbutz **B/L/D**

Dec. 24, Thursday

King Herod/Paul and Peter

Drive to the city of Caesarea Maritime built by King Herod the Great to be his capital port from where St. Paul departed on his missionary journeys, and Centurion Cornelius' meeting place with St. Peter in Acts 10.

We will visit the theater, stadium, Byzantine bath compound, Cardo road, Harbor and the Crusader gate.

Dec. 25, Friday

David and the Philistines/Goliath

After breakfast, we will drive to Shphelah and the Philistine plain day. Visit Beth Shemesh HaEla Valley Story of David and Goliath then Beit Guvrin and Bell Caves.

Dec. 26, Saturday

Triumphal Entry in Jerusalem

Start our day with prayer at the Garden Tomb. Stand on Mt. of Olives and view the old city.

Walk the Palm Sunday route, visiting the Church of Dominus Flevit (our Lord Wept).

Visit the Garden of Gethsemane's "Church of All Nations", remembering Jesus praying in the garden. Enter the old city through St.

Stephen's Gate to the Bethesda Pools, and sing at St. Anne's Crusader Church. You'll walk along the Via Dolorosa, visiting Antonia

Fortress, Stations of the Cross and spending time interpreting the chapels in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We will walk through

Zion Gate to the Church of the Dormitian (the Virgin Mary) and the Upper Room (Last Supper). Visit St. Peter in Gallicantu Church (traditional house of Caiaphas).

Dinner/ Overnight Grand Court **B/D**

Dec. 27, Sunday

Temple Mount and City of David

View the mosques: Al Aksa and the Dome of the Rock. Go to the Western Wall (Kotel), for prayer [bring your written prayers to insert in wall], and the southern wall excavations.

Visit the city of David, Areal "G" with optional walk through Hezekiah's tunnel (bring water shoes and flashlight).

Visit the Israel Museum, the Shrine of the Book (home of the Dead Sea Scrolls), the Holy Land Model of Jerusalem

Dec. 28, Monday

Jesus' birth place and stories

Tour Bethlehem Basilica of the Nativity.

Enjoy time shopping for olive wood carvings and other "treasures" from local Christian artisans. Enjoy a tent lunch at Shepherds field.

On way back to Jerusalem we will visit the Herodion Palace built by King Herod the Great and his final burial place.
